Healthy Food, Closer To Home,

First Lady Michelle Obama announced the launch of the California FreshWorks Fund, an innovative healthy food financing project of The California Endowment. This initiative is a \$200 million public-private partnership loan fund created to increase access to healthy, affordable food in underserved communities, increase economic development, and inspire innovation in healthy food retailing. The First Lady celebrated the launch of the fund by inviting partners to the White

House for a healthy foods summit with corporate and industry leaders, including Jane García, La Clínica's CEO.

Studies show that providing Californians with access to healthy food at adequate prices is a key factor to transforming food choice habits. "For lowincome people and communities of color, who face disproportionately high rates of obesity, diabetes, heart disease and other chronic diseases — this lack of access is even more critical. To truly make an impact in improving the health and wellness of our communities, every family needs to have access to healthy food. Families can't buy healthy foods that aren't available," said Jane García.

The California FreshWorks Fund (CAFWF) will work directly with grocers (produce merchants) on developing new sites to sell nutritious foods. New stores are planned to open in underserved communities and expected to create approximately 6,000 jobs in California. The fund will provide a combination of loans and grants to grocers and distributors to help overcome the high cost of entering areas where people do not have easy access to healthy, fresh foods. The CAFWF is a groundbreaking collaboration between philanthropists, grocers, the banking industry, the investment community, state and local government, community based organizations and the health care sector.

Message from the Chief Executive Officer



Jane García, La Clínica's CEO

As we celebrate 40 years of service, La Clínica's vision to provide health care to underserved communities continues to be our top priority. I am happy to announce that we have a clinic in Oakley expected to open in November of 2011. It has been a long process, but with the help of our many partners, we will be opening a 20 hour per week satellite medical

clinic with a capacity to increase access to primary care for the uninsured in East Contra Costa County.

The clinic will serve approximately 1,144 patients in the first year and will provide high quality primary medical care services for families, health education and social services. In the second year, we hope to offer pre-natal care and referral services. The facility will have one provider and one medical assistant, along with several clinical staff. We hope to expand the operation to 40 hours a week within a year and have three full-time health care providers committed to that expansion.

Since the early 1990s, Contra Costa County has drastically increased in population; over one third of this population growth occurred in East Contra Costa County alone. The health care infrastructure in East Contra Costa County has not evolved to meet the needs of the diverse and increasingly disadvantaged population. With the rising number of uninsured residents, decreasing number of Medi-Cal providers and the lack of bilingual, culturally competent providers, many residents in East Contra Costa County are left without access to basic health care services. Many residents who lack primary care services resort to emergency rooms at nearby hospitals as a medical home. Additionally, public transportation options in the area are severely limited, creating a barrier for residents attempting to seek health care outside of their area.

After conducting a community needs assessment two years ago, La Clínica was approached by the Contra Costa Interfaith Supporting Community Organizations, the City of Oakley, Kaiser Permanente, John Muir/Mt. Diablo Medical Center, and Sutter Delta Medical Center about expanding health care services to residents in East Contra Costa County. Our own assessment confirmed that East Contra Costa County is an area where many residents lack access to primary care services.

Our goal at La Clínica is to provide a comprehensive clinic where patients have access to a variety of services. We strive to provide a continuum of quality health care services that promote the community's wellness and access to preventive, primary, and specialty care. I am thrilled to finally bring these critical services to the residents of East Contra Costa County!
