



Family HealthCare Network is a private, non-profit, community-based organization established in Porterville, California in 1976. FHCN is the first freestanding ambulatory health care center in Tulare County to be accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations and currently has 17 locations throughout central California, 14 of which are clinical sites. Family HealthCare Network is governed by a volunteer Board of Directors composed of community representatives and patients/consumers. More than half (55%) of the population served by FHCN are migrant farm workers. Overall, seventyfive percent of FHCN patients are of Hispanic origin and forty-four percent speak a language other than English. Most are families, with eighty-four percent of them living below the federal poverty line. A high percentage lack access to any other source of health care because of financial, linguistic, cultural, geographic or transportation barriers. Today, the organization has a comprehensive primary health care delivery system spread throughout California's Central Valley, with health centers located in Porterville, Visalia, Ivanhoe, Woodlake, Springville, Three Rivers, Goshen, Hanford, Cutler-Orosi, Terra Bella and Farmersville.
