

Fact Sheet: FHCN's Woodlake and Farmersville Health Centers

WOODLAKE

- Located at 201 E. Lakeview, facility opened May 7, 2012 (FHCN had been operating 3,700-sq.-ft. clinic at 101 N. Palm in former Woodlake Memorial Hospital building since 1999)
- Woodlake Health Center, constructed at a cost of \$3 million, is 11,300 square feet and includes 19 exam rooms and 9 dental operatories.
- A total of 33 people are currently employed at the Woodlake Health Center, including 9 providers.
- Woodlake's current population is approximately 7,700. According to the 2010 U.S. 87% of residents self-identified as Hispanic or Latino.
- Woodlake's economy is heavily dependent on agriculture and much of the population is employed as agricultural workers or in local citrus packing houses.
- Woodlake is averaging 1,667 visits per month this fiscal year (with a total visits in FY12 of about 20,000). The first month the new Woodlake Health Center was operational, it had 1,763 visits. The facility had 1,959 visits in June (19.5% increase over May).

FARMERSVILLE

- Located at 730 N. Farmersville Boulevard, facility opened January 28, 2012. (Prior to its opening FHCN had never operated a health center in Farmersville.)
- The Farmersville Health Center was constructed at a cost of approximately \$875,000 (including the cost of the land acquisition.) A New Access Point grant from HRSA contributed \$616,000 in construction funding.
- The facility is 4,000 square feet and includes 12 exam rooms.
- Currently, 22 full-time employees work at the facility, including 6 providers.
- Farmersville's current population is 10,580. According to the 2010 U.S. 83% of the population self-identified as Hispanic or Latino.
- The economy of Farmersville is heavily dependent on agriculture and much of the population is employed as agricultural workers.
- Anticipated patient encounters in Year 1 of the facility's operation = 19,163; Year 2 = 26,810
- Anticipated unduplicated users in Year 1 = 5,625; Year 2 = 7,500
- Since it opened, the Farmersville Health Center is averaging 1,289 visits per month (almost 6,500 total visits since late January).

General FHCN Demographics (according to 2011 UDS report):

- 79.50% of patients below 100% of poverty level (and 94% under 200% of poverty level)
- 59% Female
- 43% age 19 or younger (and 4.5% age 65 or older)
- 76% Hispanic/Latino
- 43% of patients best served in a language other than English

Payment types/Insurance

- 54% on Medi-Cal
- 5% on Medicare
- 29% uninsured

Migrant-specific Health Statistics

- 55% of patients (61,689 patients out of 111,659)
- 81.60% of patients below 100% of poverty level (and 95% under 200% of poverty level)
- 58% female
- 93% Hispanic/Latino Ethnicity
