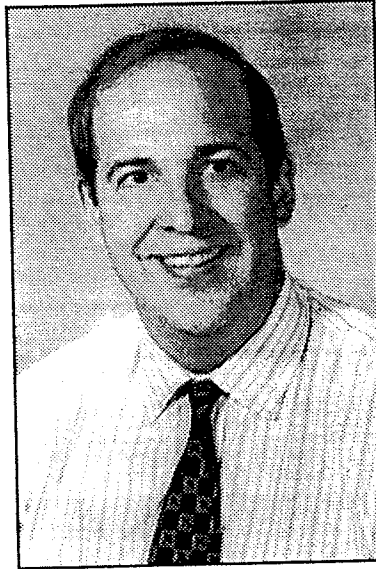
Dr. Matthew G. Weeks, medical director of Golden Valley Health Centers, was the recent recipient of the American Academy of Pediatrics Prep Award.
