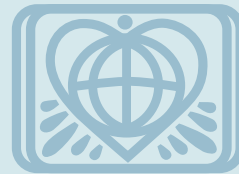

Support Services

Every Woman Matters - is a cancer prevention program that offers qualified patients free annual pap smears and mammograms. Women qualify if they are 40 years of age or older, meet income criteria, and do not have insurance, Medicaid or Medicare.

Interpreters - Most of our providers are bilingual in English and Spanish and interpreters are available for those who are not.

Pharmacy & Medication Assistance - affordable medication is available on-site at the pharmacy. Assistance with enrollment in discount medication programs for income-eligible patients is also available.

Disease Management - OneWorld offers education, follow-up care, coordination, case management, and peer education, including care for sexually transmitted diseases, latent tuberculosis, high lead levels and care for chronic diseases, such as asthma, diabetes, hypertension, high cholesterol and depression.

Social Work - OneWorld staff can assist patients with basic food, shelter, clothing and medication needs by coordinating with community and government services such as Kids Connection, social services and Medicaid on a case by case basis.

Women Infants & Children Nutrition - WIC provides nutrition education and food vouchers to income-eligible mothers who are pregnant, postpartum, or breast feeding, and to their children under 5 years of age.

Medicaid Enrollment - OneWorld offers assistance in applying for Medicaid. To qualify for Medicaid, a person must be a citizen or legal resident of the United States and must meet income guidelines. Unborn children are also eligible for Medicaid.

Specialist Referrals - Referrals for services not available at the clinic can be made for patients of OneWorld. Appointments for patients without insurance or with limited incomes are made through Hope Medical Outreach Coalition, a network of volunteer physicians, hospitals, and other medical facilities.

Charges for Care - OneWorld accepts most insurance, Medicaid and Medicare. For people without insurance, and living on limited income, proof of one month's worth of income is required to determine the fees for services rendered.

Funding Sources - OneWorld is a community health center funded by federal and state grants, local foundations and corporations, the United Way of the Midlands, private contributions and patient fees.
