What is a Certified Midwife?

Certified nurse midwives have received their bachelors and masters of science degrees in nursing, are graduates of a midwifery education program accredited by the American College of Nurse-Midwives and have passed a rigorous national certification exam.

A certified nurse midwife is a skilled healthcare professional who provides healthcare to women. This includes evaluation, assessment, treatment and referral to a specialist, if required. Midwives emphasize health promotion, education and disease prevention. Midwives provide care during pregnancy and childbirth, normal gynecological services and care of the peri- and post-menopausal women.
