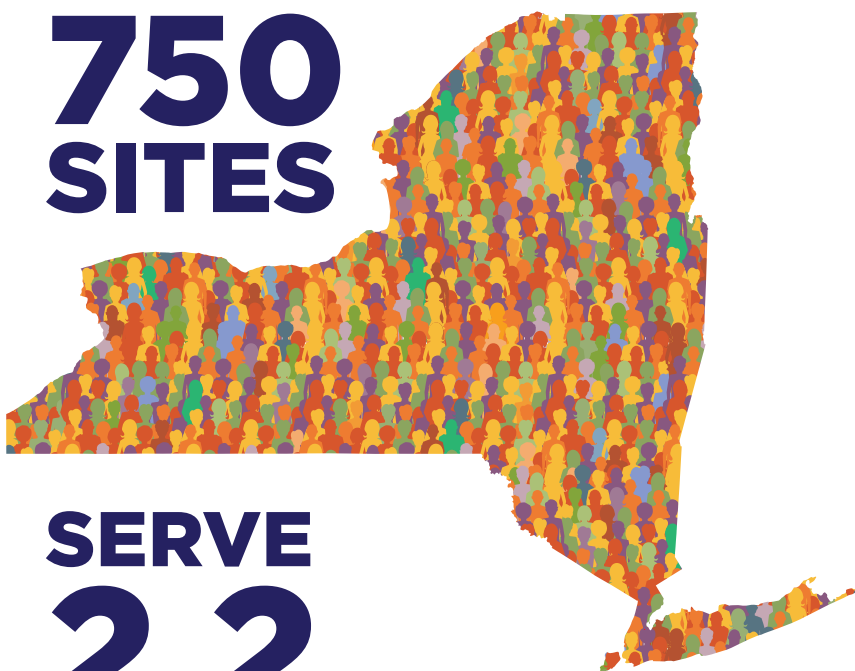


# FEDERALLY QUALIFIED HEALTH CENTERS



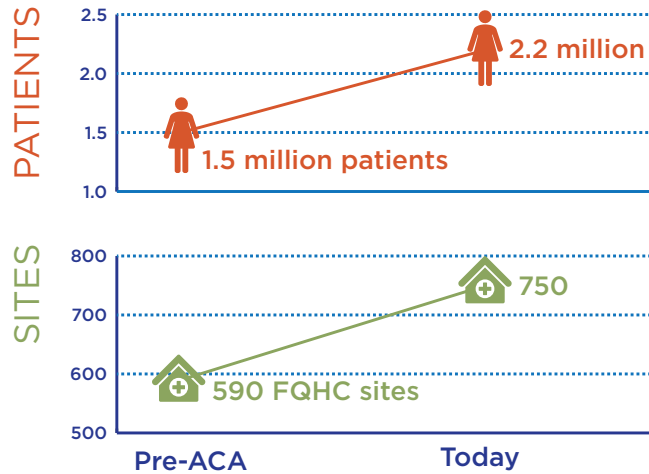

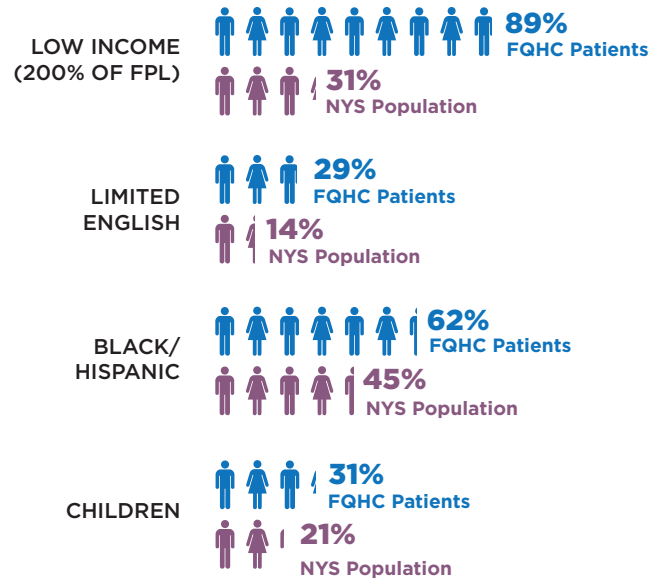
## INCREASING ACCESS

In the five years since the implementation of the Affordable Care Act, 690,000 additional New Yorkers have gained access to primary care at an FQHC.



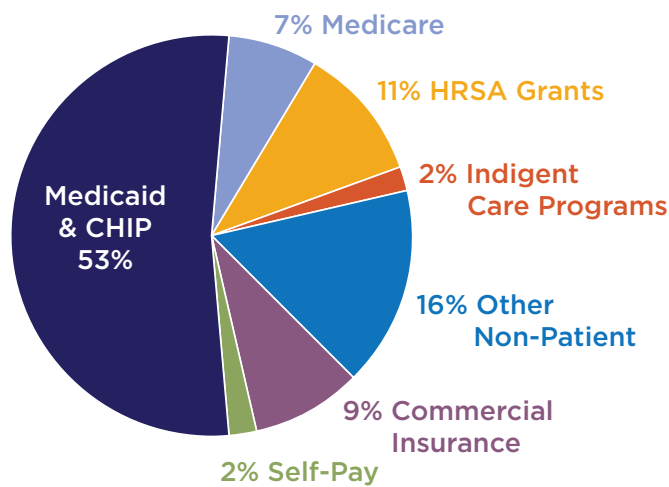
## CARING FOR NEW YORKERS
